• What is the best way to fundraise online?

It's so easy to set up a fundraising webpage. Websites like justgiving.com and localgiving.org allow fundraisers to set up a donation page that you can share with friends and family online. Your supporters can donate directly via these websites meaning your donations are transferred quickly and safely to RSVP.

How do I start fundraising for RSVP online?

To begin fundraising via Local Giving, visit <u>localgiving.org/charity/rsvp-wm/</u> and click 'Fundraise for Us'. Follow the next steps to set up a fundraising page.

To begin fundraising via Just Giving, visit www.justgiving.com to search for RSVP (The Rape and Sexual Violence Project) and select 'Start Fundraising'. Follow the next steps to set up a fundraising page

Once your fundraising page has been set up, you will be able to share it via text or to your social media platforms.
