Mark* is one of the brave survivors we have worked with. He suffered abuse as a child, but never felt able to tell anyone until he met with a counsellor.

"...the counsellor asked me if there was anything else I would like to talk about. Suddenly it came out, I replied, "Yes I was abused when I was 11", the counsellor said that she had been waiting for me to say it. I cried like I've never cried before, it had finally come out and I had finally opened up."

Mark said that without the help of counsellors at RSVP, he wouldn't be where he is today.

"I think and feel more clearly. If I'm struggling, I talk about it. I'm more open and honest about how I'm feeling...All of this would never have been possible without the help, guidance and support of RSVP."

ENSURING SURVIVORS ARE HEARD

WHY

Lisa* is a survivor who has used our ISVA (Independent Sexual Violence Advocate) service. She found that a helping hand from her advocate was just what she needed.

"I was so confused after hearing different things from different police forces and was already in crisis when the latest attack occurred. My ISVA was amazing. Friendly, approachable, knowledgeable and explained everything really clearly. She was really flexible and patient and answered all my questions."

Lisa said that the support of her ISVA was vital in helping her to restart her life after the abuse.

"I was long overdue for a smear test and also hadn't had a STI check since the last incident had occurred. I can honestly say I could not have gone through with the tests without this support.. She waited with me, despite the long wait at the clinic."
